## Icon Global Coach: Miguel Novillo Astrada



Miguel "Miki" Novillo Astrada began his professional polo career when he won the 1987 *Copa Potrillo*. Numerous other victories followed in Argentina, including the *Copa República*. In 1994 he won the youth tournament of the Argentine Open. Since 1998 his success continued in the USA, winning both he won the CV Whitney Cup and the US Open.

Miguel has attained the sport's highest handicap of 10 goals and some of his greatest achievements include winning the *Triple Corona* 2003 (winning the

Tortugas Open , Hurlingham Open and Argentine Open in one year). America's Cup 2004, Tortugas Open 2004, Hurlingham Open 2008, C.V. Whitney Cup and Ylvisaker Cup 2012, Herbie Pannell Cup and East Coast Open 2015, Evolution Cup 2018, Argentine 20 Goal Metropolitano Championship 2018. He has competed 13 times in the Argentine Open Series.
